

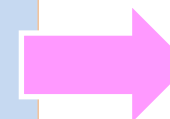

## External School Review November 2016 Directives

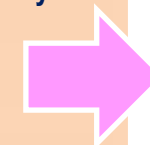
## TARGETS

## STRATEGIES

- Staff PD & Trial of Embedding Formative Assessment
- Staff to provide opportunities for Intellectual Stretch through differentiation and transforming learning tasks
- Mathematics ICAS for comparison data
- Parents involved in learning goals with children including 3 way interviews
- Investigate Quick Smart learning intervention
- Continued staff work with Moderation
- Early Years Reggio philosophy-(nature learning areas)
- Network Learning Groups,
- Brightpath Writing continuum for analysis with NAPLAN next steps
- STEM- Technology learning R-7
- T4 Community Forum- Progress and Feedback for Future planning
- Positive Education- resilience & growth mind set learning

- Staff using formative assessment techniques with classes to empower students
