COVID- 19 & ILLNESS.

Firstly, a HUGE Thank you to those families who have kept their child/ren home and tested them just in case it has been the Covid-Virus. I have been notified over the weekend and today that we do have some students who have tested positive to Covid. A letter was emailed out yesterday to those families in the class concerned, as they are class contacts. In the case of being a class contact students may continue to come to school BUT if they display any signs of any illness, please keep them at home and I strongly urge you to get your child tested. Thank you to those families who notified me as soon as was practical, this certainly helps with our processes of communication.

Please remember your child may or may not present with any symptoms of any illness, and if you feel they may have been in contact with a person testing positive to Covid, please keep them at home for the 7 days as this is the best place for them, and to keep everyone else safe. The change of season has already brought along some sniffles and once again I thank those families who are keeping students at home and checking to ensure there is not a possibility of it being Covid, and, also to prevent illness from spreading.

It is an expectation if parents are coming onto the Blyth Primary School grounds that a face mask is worn even outdoors. In normal circumstances we love to see our families visit, but I am requesting until the end of this term, if possible, please limit your visits. The staff and I are always available by telephone, email, Skoolbag, and Class Dojo, and only too happy to assist with any matters you may have through these communication platforms.
